Dear Colleagues,

Delhi University Library System has regularly been contributing in different ways to support the teaching, learning and research activities across the University. As a further step in this direction we have taken an initiative to update the research profiles of all the faculty members on the Indian Research Information Network System (IRINS) platform. IRINS is web-based Research Information Management (RIM) service developed by the Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET) Centre. The portal facilitates the academic, R&D organizations and faculty members, scientists to collect, curate and showcase the scholarly communication activities and provide an opportunity to create the scholarly network.

Hosting profiles on this platform would significantly increase the visibility of the faculty members/research scholars as it is an open access platform. Thus, the users of those institutions which do not have subscriptions to expensive databases like SCOPUS, would be able to see publications of the University of Delhi faculty members. It would further increase the visibility and citation count of the publications. The university of Delhi profile page is available at du.irins.org

A Delhi University Research Information Management (DURIM) team has been constituted at the Central Library. The DURIM team shall monitor the progress of profile creation, completeness of profiles and serve as a support service to assist the faculty members in creation of different IDs like ORCID ID, Google scholar ID, etc. All faculty members are requested to provide data as per the attached format. The collected data will be populated on the platform to create faculty profiles.
